

Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium 2018-2019

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2).

Type of support

At Rosehill School we will use catch-up premium to:

- Ensure all staff new to school are trained to deliver Colourful Semantics on Reading and Writing and other Rosehill specific reading and writing strategies (for example spelling arc and visual discrimination) in order to achieve functional literacy for as many pupils as possible, and so to close the reading achievement gap for vulnerable children working below age-expected levels.
- Ensure all staff are trained to deliver Numicon within lessons and as a small group or 1:1 intervention to build deep understanding and engagement through active investigation with problem solving at its core.
- Ensure that detailed assessments are undertaken so that any interventions can be targeted at specific areas of weakness e.g. fluency in reading.
