### **Message from the Headteacher**

Thank you to everyone who returned one of the annual child and parent/carer questionnaires at the end of the Summer term. I am delighted by the responses and comments we received. You will hopefully see how these have been used in focusing our future developments for the year ahead. It is good to see that the hard work that goes on at school has been recognised. We very much rely on this process as a way of evaluating the performance of our school for the last year and have identified strengths along with aspects that we will continue to work together to develop.

We feel that it is important that the responses are fed back to you as parents and carers, to keep you informed. The questionnaire is a real way for parents and carers to be heard and I would like to ensure that this response rate is improved in the coming year. Your comments are very helpful in focusing our future school developments to make further improvements. I have compiled this summary of the responses we received. ### **Background**

Our parent/ carer survey was carried out over July 2019, responses were received from 45 parents and carers. Thank you to everyone who took the time to complete the questionnaires as we value and appreciate your feedback and continued support and promise to consider all views.

### **Purpose**

The purpose of the questionnaire is to offer parents and carers with an opportunity to provide feedback on a variety of issues so we can improve the services we offer to our children and families. The questionnaire also helps us with our Self Evaluation Form (SEF) and School Development Plans that is a requirement from Ofsted, which the school completes each year. Parent and carer views give us the chance to inform Ofsted, Governors and other extended services what our families think about Rosehill School and ways to improve.

The Questionnaire asks for parents and carers opinions on 18 aspects of the child's school, from the quality of teaching and learning, to managing bullying and behaviour. Parents and carers can see what other parents have said about Rosehill School or view the results for any school in England.

We have also asked parents and carers to share with us additional comments and suggestions in order to ensure we take into consideration further improvements and ideas they wish to share. The deciding criterion includes:

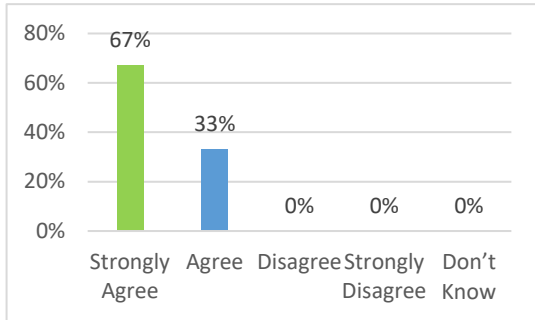

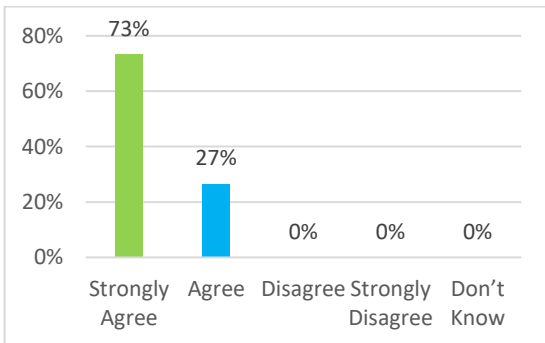

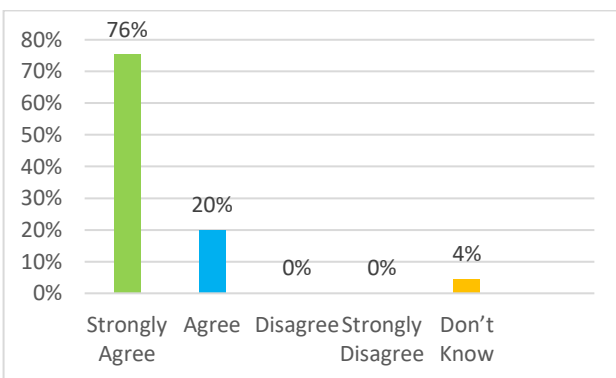
#### 1. My child is happy at school and enjoys school



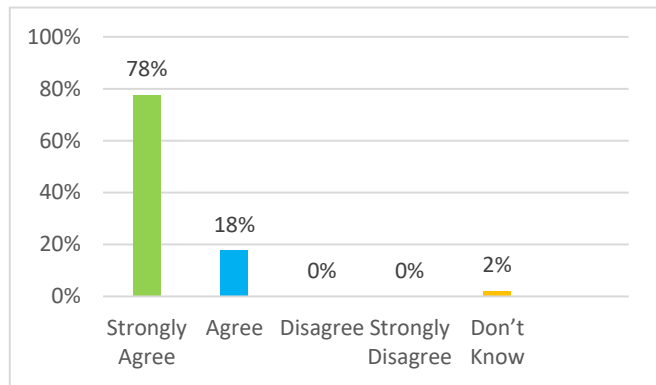
#### 2. There is a happy atmosphere at school



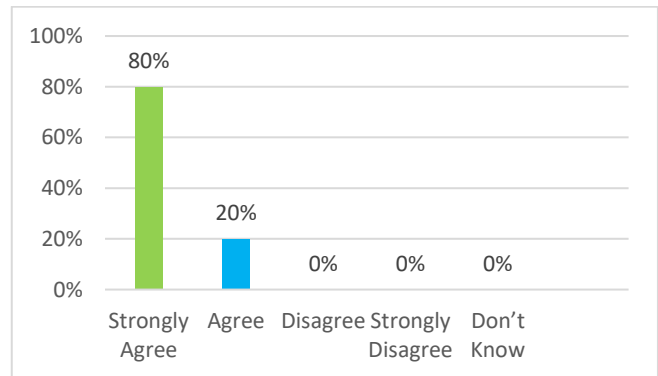
#### 3. My child feels safe at school

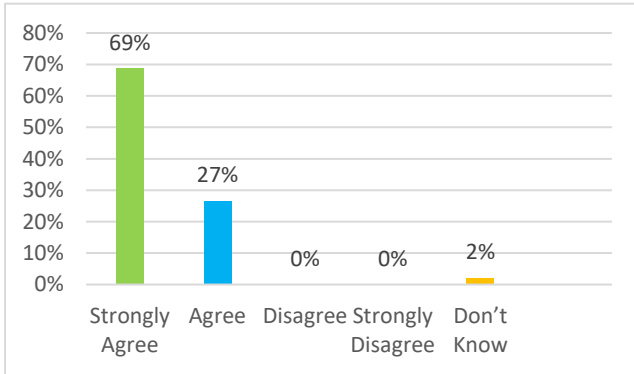

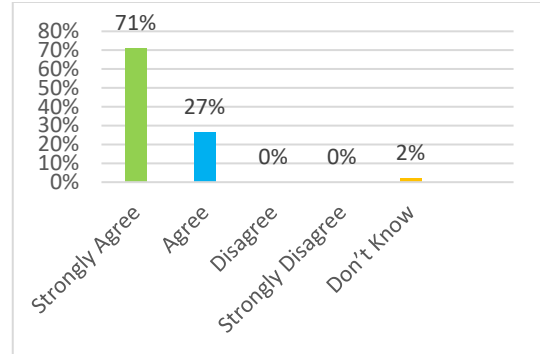

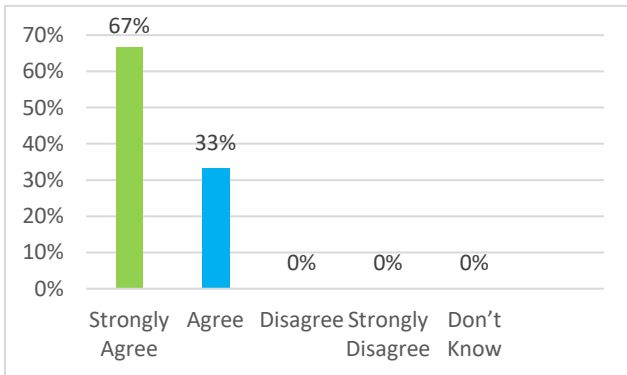
**6. Rosehill has high expectations for my child**



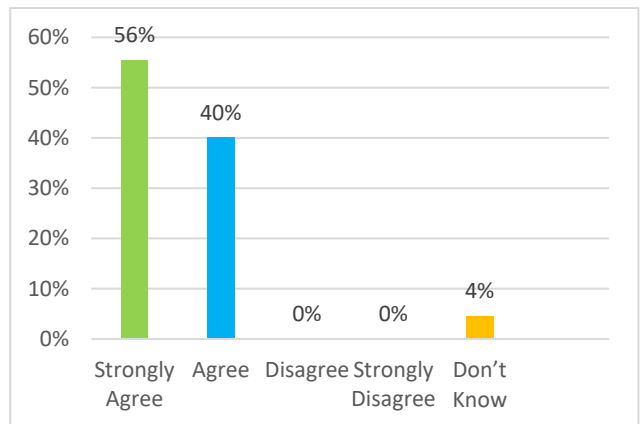
**8. I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress**



**7. My child makes good progress at school (education, learning, behaviour, communication and health)**

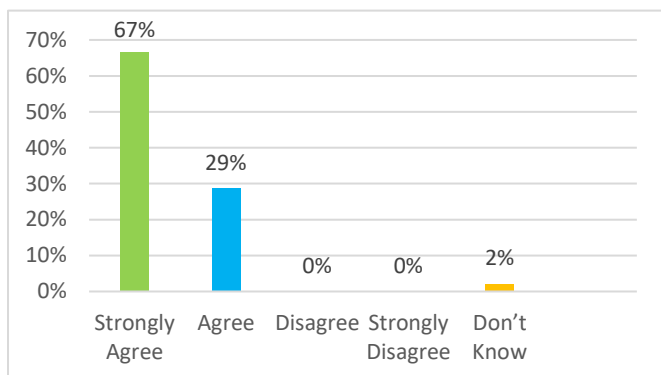


**9. Lessons are exciting and reflect a broad and balanced curriculum**

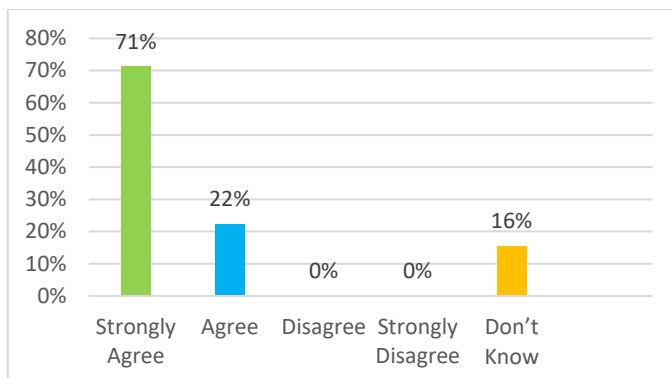

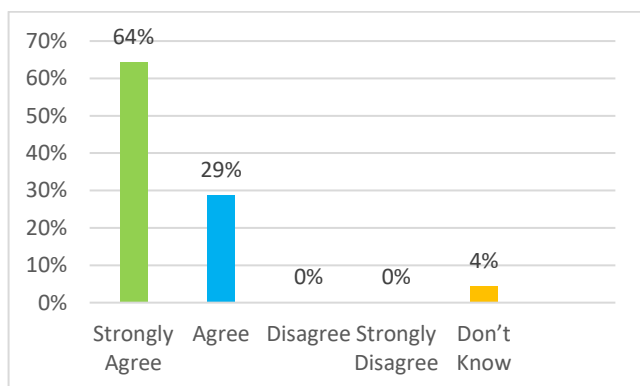
**10. I think the school's system of rewarding and praising children are effective**



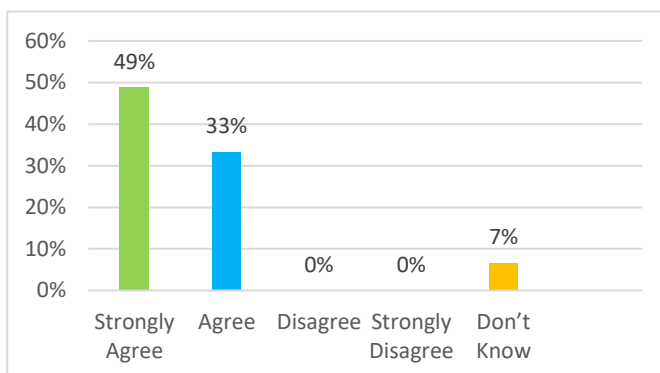
**13. The school promotes the importance of good attendance and encourages my child to attend regularly**



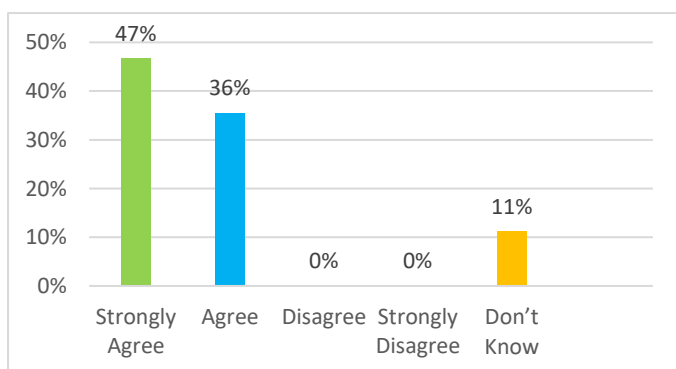
**11. The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved**



**14. My child may receive activities to take part in at home (e.g. reading books, PECS symbols, shared topic ideas)**

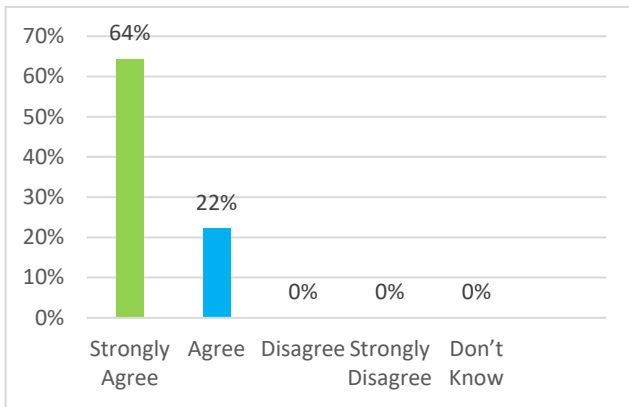

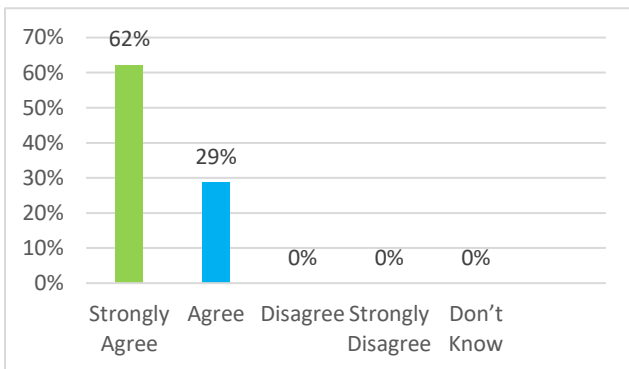

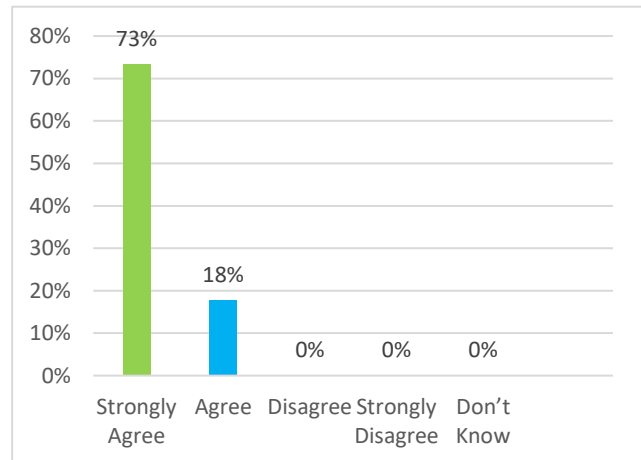
### 17. The school encourages parents/carers to play an active part in school life
