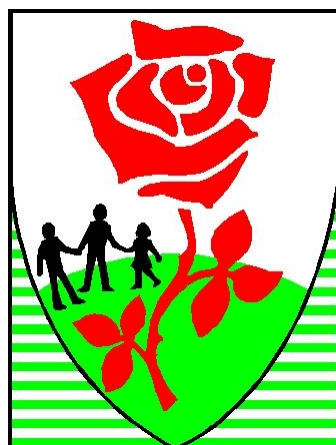


Rosehill School

Background

Our parent/ carer survey was carried out over 2017 (July and September), responses were received from 57 parents/ carers. Thank you to everyone who took the time to complete the questionnaires as we value and appreciate your feedback and continued support and promise to consider all views.

Purpose

The purpose of the questionnaire is to offer parents / carers with an opportunity to provide feedback on a variety of issues so we can improve the services we offer to our children and families. The questionnaire also helps us with our Self Evaluation Form (SEF) and School Development plans which is a requirement from Ofsted which we must complete each year. Parent / carer views gives us the chance to tell Ofsted what our families think about Rosehill School. The information parents/ carers provide is used when Ofsted decide to inspect our school.

The Questionnaire asks for parent's/ carers opinions on 14 aspects of the child's school, from the quality of teaching and learning, to managing bullying and behaviour. 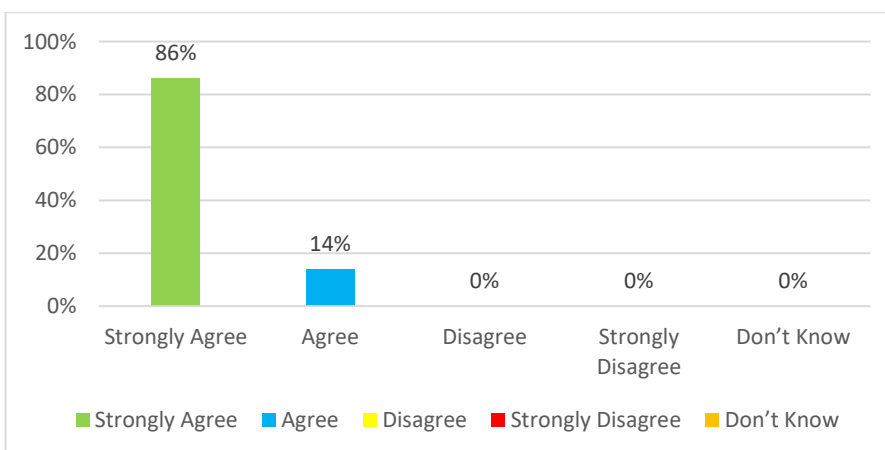
2. My child feels safe at school



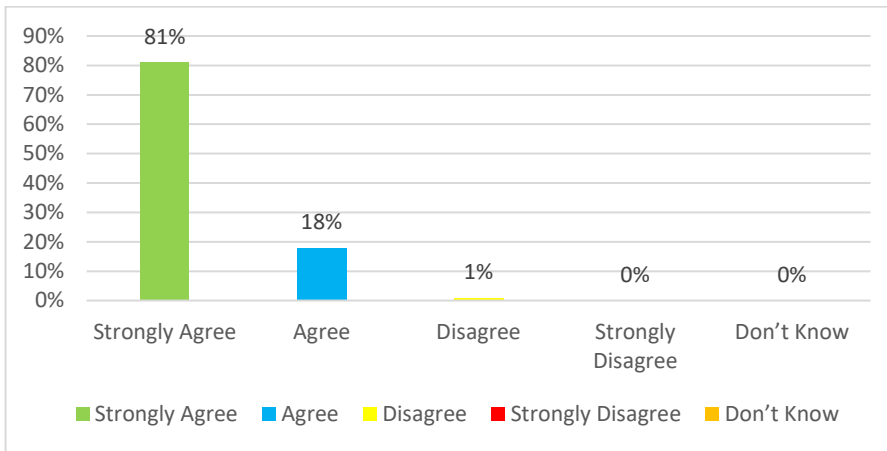

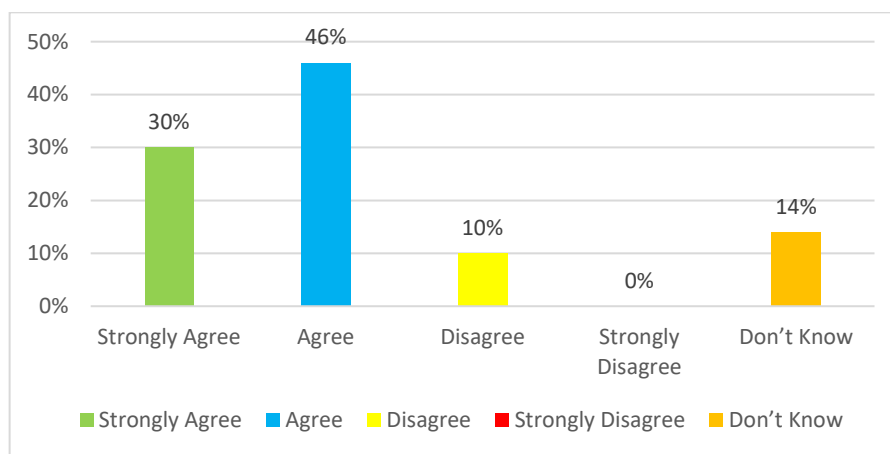
