Purpose

The questionnaire also helps us with our Self Evaluation Form (SEF) and School Development plans which is a requirement from Ofsted which we must complete each year. 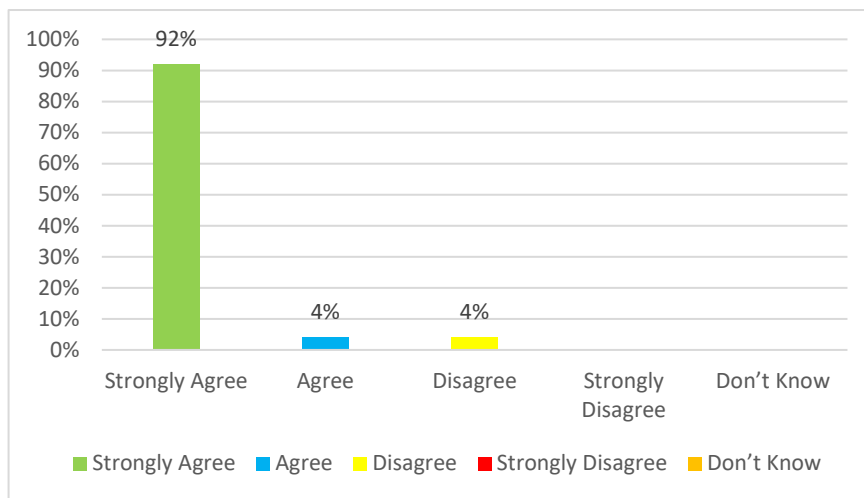

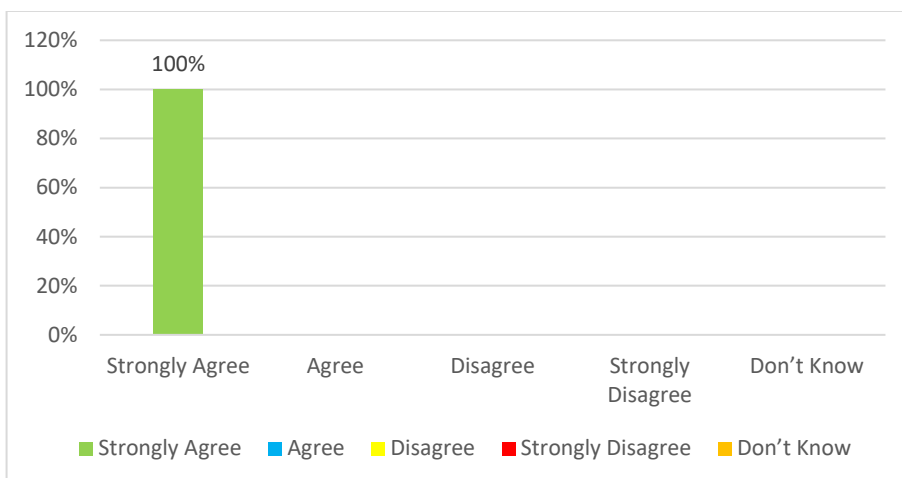

1. My child is happy at this school



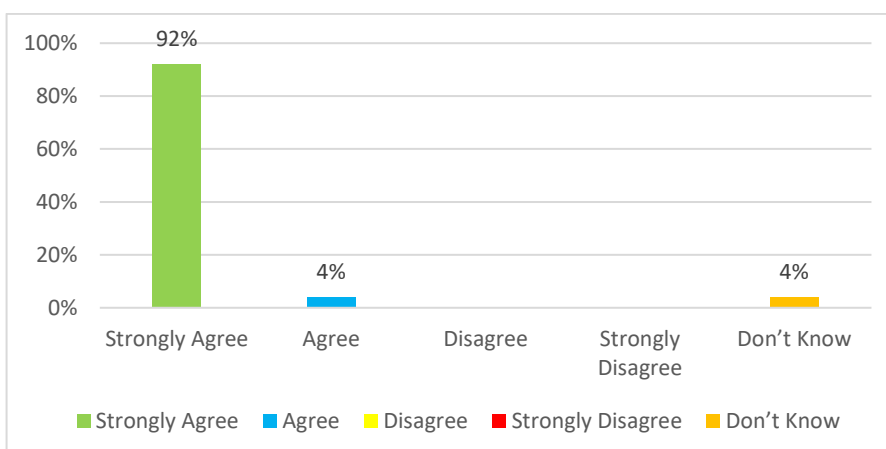

2. My child feels safe at this school



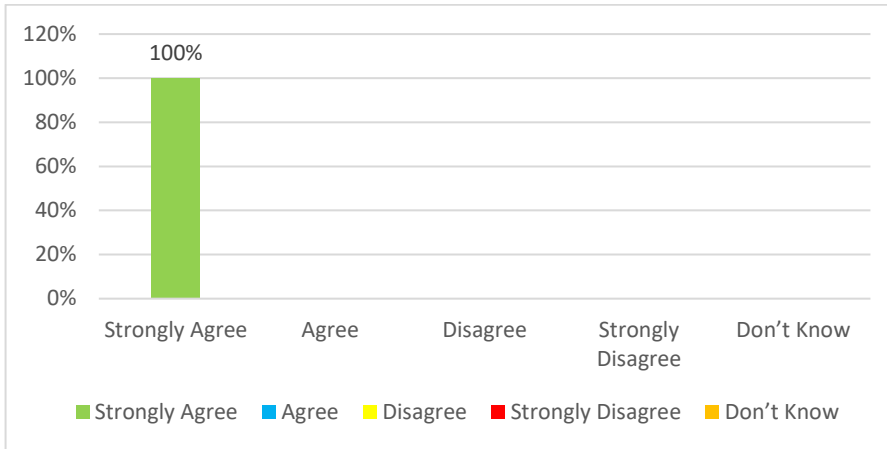

3. My child makes good progress at this school



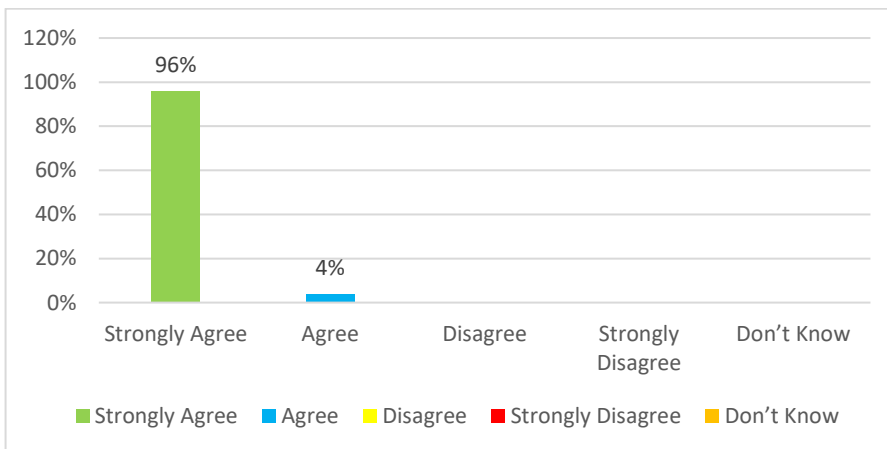

4. My child is well looked after at this school



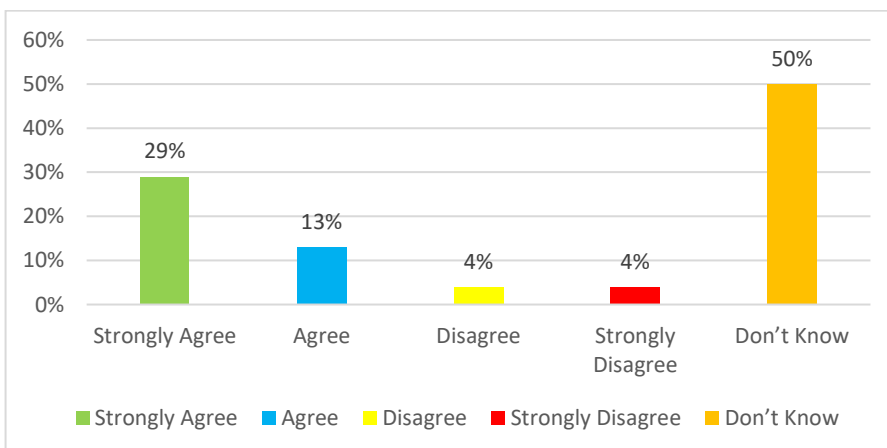

5. My child is taught well at this school



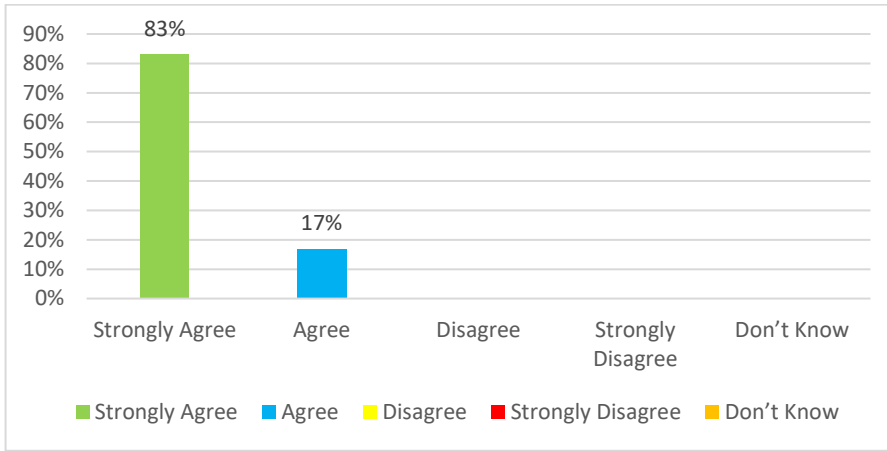

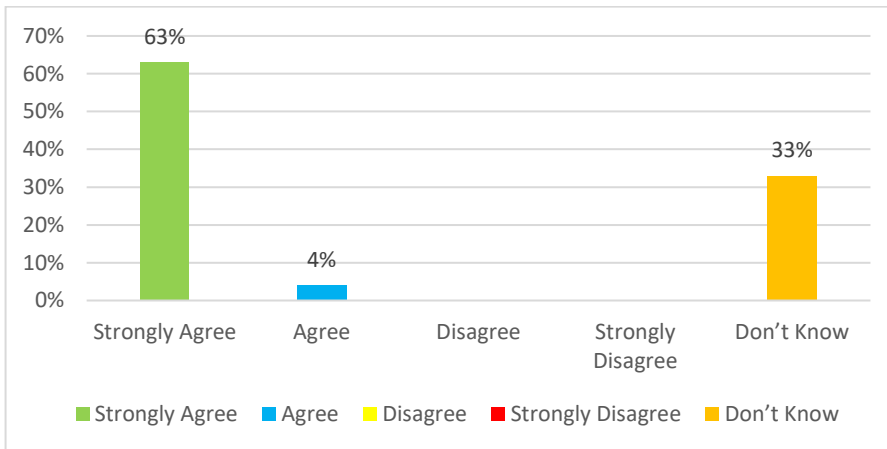

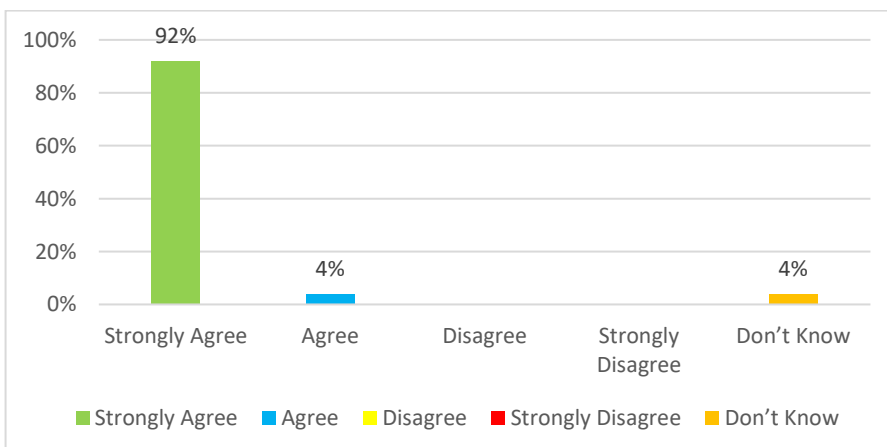

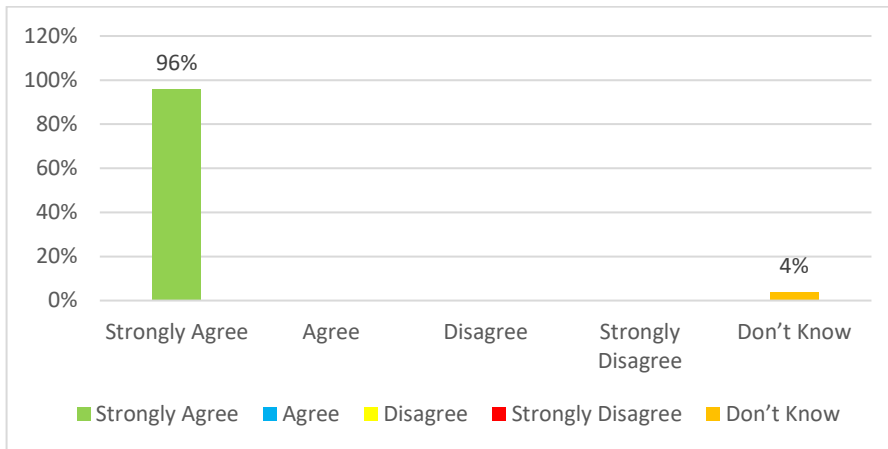

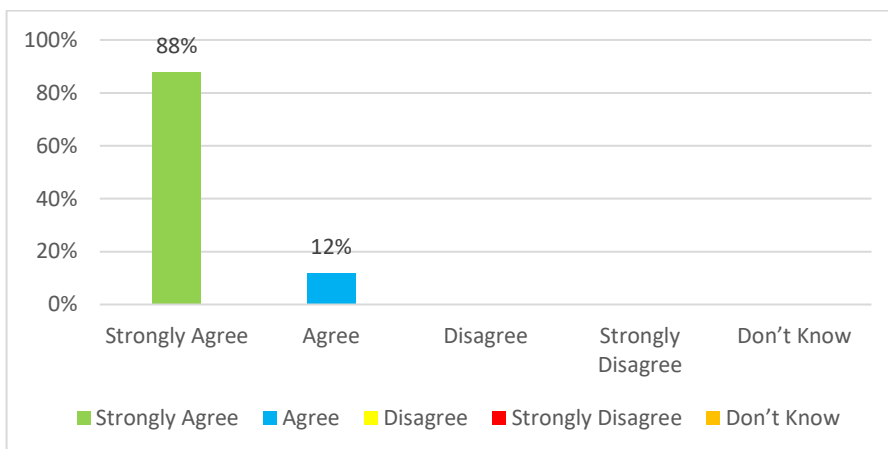

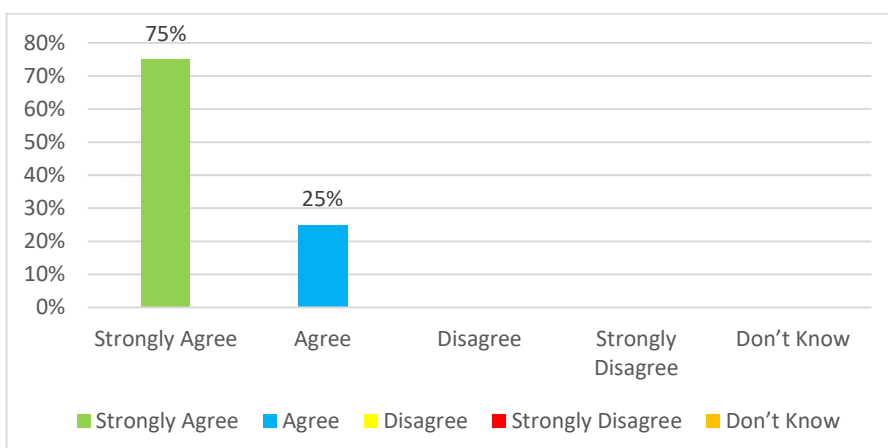

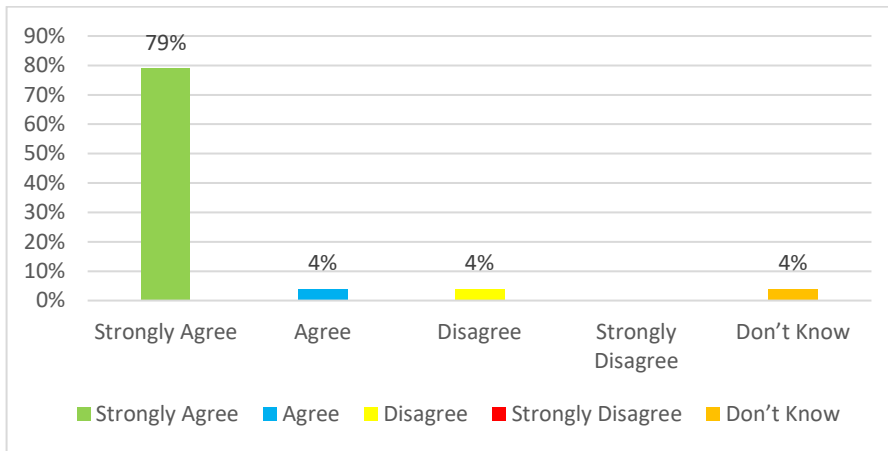

12. I understand the role and responsibility of the Governing Body



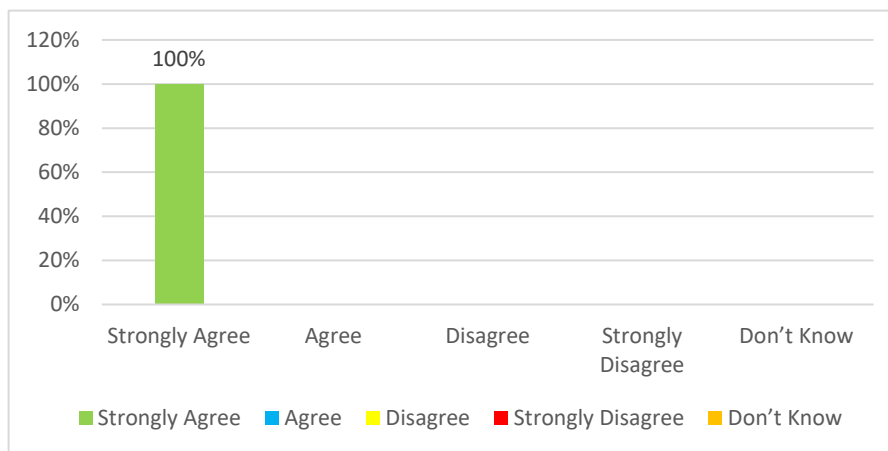
