



### What you need:

- Cups
- Straws
- Paint
- Washing up liquid
- Water
- Paper

### Instructions:

- Add a tablespoon of paint colour
- Add 2 tablespoons of washing liquid
- Add 2 tablespoons of water
- Mix
- Blow bubbles inside the cup with straw up to the rim
- Lay paper over bubbles and repeat



## Rainbow BUBBLE SNAKES

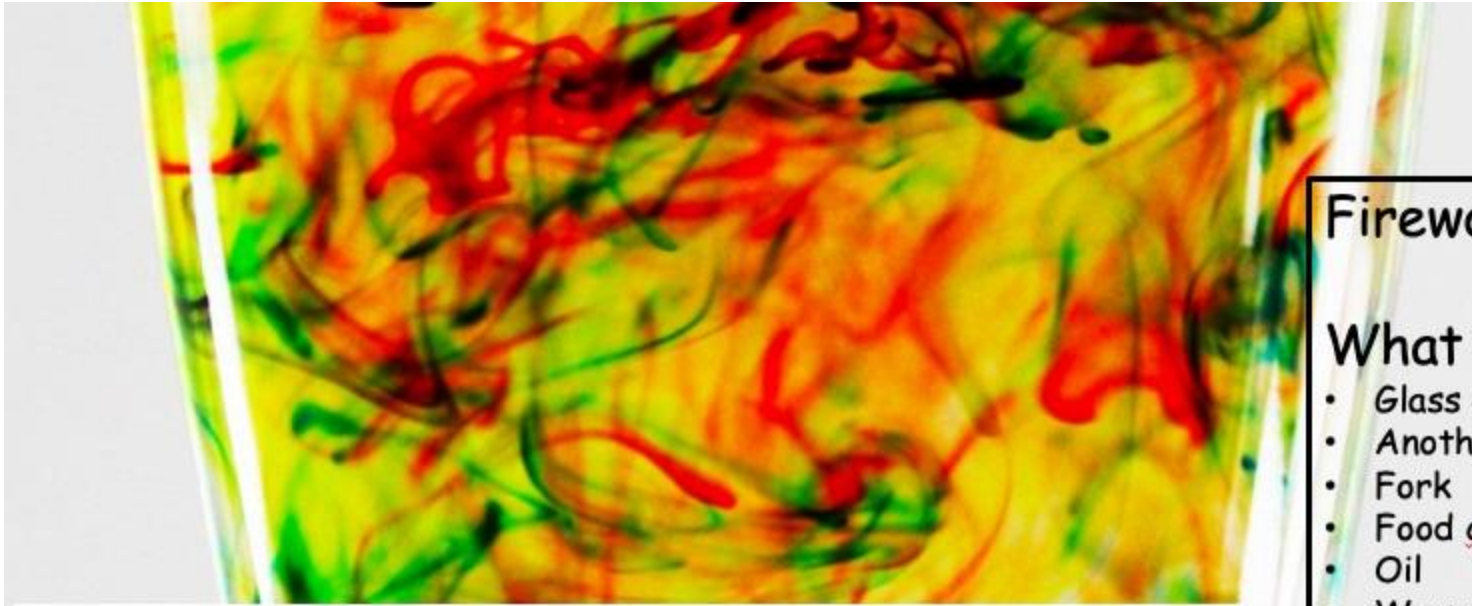


### What you need:

- Old bottle
- Old sock
- Tape or elastic band
- Washing up liquid
- Water
- Bowl
- Food colouring (optional)

### Instructions:

- Cut bottom of bottle off
- Slide sock over bottom of the bottle
- Secure it with tape or elastic band
- Pour washing up liquid into shallow bowl with water and mix
- Add colour (optional)
- Dip the sock covered bubble blower into solution and blow



## Fireworks in a glass

### What you need:

- Glass or clear cup / bowl
- Another cup (for mixing)
- Fork
- Food colouring
- Oil
- Warm Water

### Instructions:

- Fill container with  $\frac{3}{4}$  warm water
- In a separate cup add a few table spoons of oil
- Add approx. 4 drops of colouring
- Use a fork, give oil and colouring a mix to break up into 'colour beads'
- Carefully pour oil and food colouring mixture to the water and watch the effects





## DIY Foam paint

### What you need:

- Shaving foam
- PVA glue
- Food colouring or paint
- Mixing bowl and spoon

### Instructions:

- Mix equal parts shaving foam and glue
- Add colouring or paint
- Use on concrete or paper and create pictures



## Mini volcanoes

### What you need:

- Small shallow containers
- An overflow tray (oven tray?)
- Food colouring or paint
- Washing up liquid
- Glitter (optional)
- Bicarbonate of Soda
- Salt
- Vinegar

### Instructions:

- Fill small containers with 2 tbsp of baking soda
- Add  $\frac{1}{2}$  tbsp of salt to each mixture
- Pour a few drops of food colouring or paint
- Add a few drops of washing up liquid to each pot
- Stir ingredients
- Pour vinegar to watch 'eruption'
- Repeat
