






-  Ask  a grown up to make sure  your  tin cans have




-  no  sharp edges, and are  clean and  dry.






-  Use  green  paint to  paint  all over  your tin cans and

-  wait for them to  dry.


-  Use  tape or  glue to  stick your  cans  on top of

 each other  to make a tree  shape.

• Use  glue  to stick  on  wool,  string and  different
