It is on the 11<sup>th</sup> November.

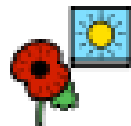

the second Sunday of November.

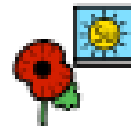

Poppies

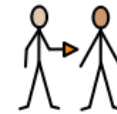


Poppies are flowers that help people to remember about the soldiers that have been injured or killed in lots of different wars.

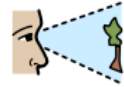
People wear paper poppies to show that they are thinking about the soldiers that have fought in the wars.



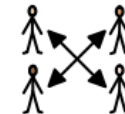

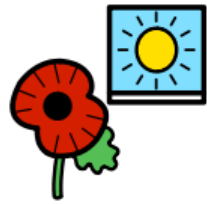
On Remembrance Day, these poppy wreaths are placed on statues and monuments.

Remembrance Day parades take place in lots of cities. Men and women who have served in the military march to the monuments to lay a poppy wreath.



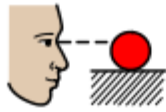
