Key Objectives

At the end of the Transition Fair pupils and parents will:

- Have gained knowledge of the post 18 services available to them from different organisations across the city.
- Have a clearer idea of timelines and when / how to apply for different services i.e colleges.
- Have had the opportunity to engage with organisations, providers and pupils from other schools.

The Transitions Fair is an opportunity for parents and young people to engage with different organisations in order to support their understanding of what is available for them once they transition on from Rosehill.

With the support of Rowan form Futures, parents are given a better understanding of timelines, when and how to apply for different services such as colleges and day services.




Impact on Parents and Young People




Parents fed back that the fair was very helpful and informative.
