Pupils were able to demonstrate their learning through participation and engagement with peers and teachers

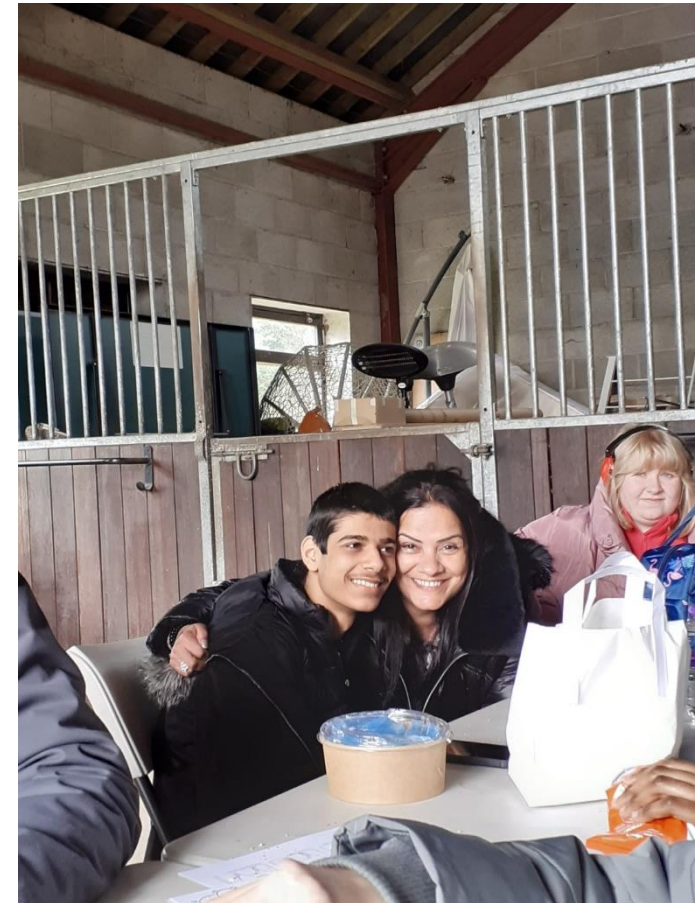
