Project Content

- Children were introduced to the concept of the production and given a significant historical event to research and learn about.
- Classes were provided with scripts to follow and opportunity to develop their own scenes creatively.
- Classes were asked to create their own costumes and props to bring their scenes to life!
- Children rehearsed their scenes on stage and were recorded live.
- Classes performed their scenes as a traditional play for the school to enjoy.
