**What is Child Protection?**  
 At Rosehill School, all of the adults think that your health, safety and wellbeing are very important. We want you to be happy and to be able to learn.

**How will we try to protect you?**

**Who can you talk to?**  
 If you are worried about something, you can talk to an adult in school. This could be your teacher or any of these adults.

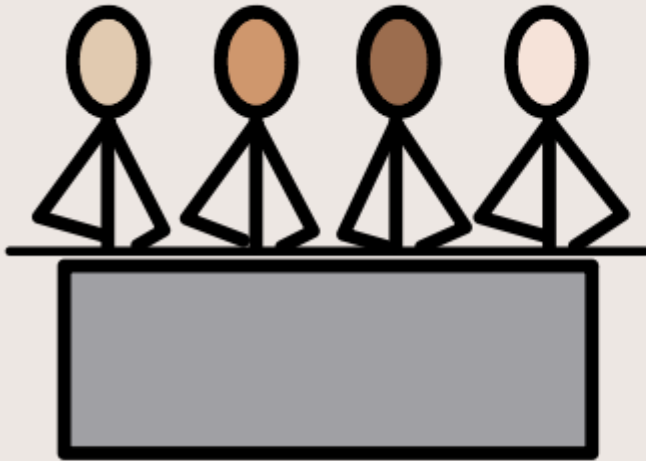

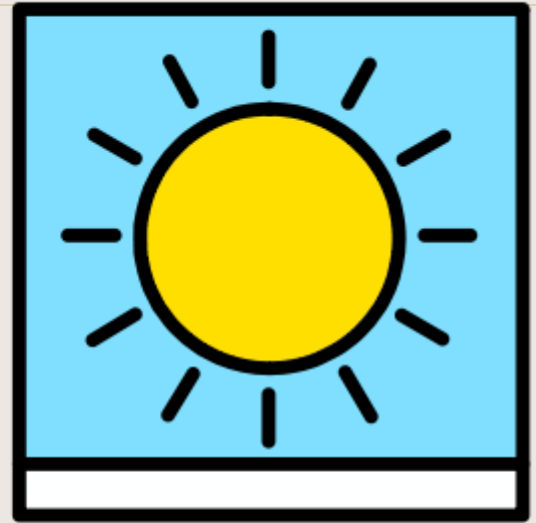
